5. Why is Moses so reluctant to do what God says? Is this stubbornness the same as disobedience?

6. What is the significance of the name of God?

7. Why is the name they are to remember different from the name God gives himself?

8. Read Exodus 4:1-17. What makes Moses refuse to do God's work, even with these signs?

9. What does 4:16 mean?



10. Read Mark 14:53-65. Why does Jesus' answer to the question get the high priest so worked up?

11. Read Acts 3:1-10. With what authority does this healing take place? Does this mean that the name of God has been superseded?



12. In Christ, the fullness of the deity dwells. If Jesus is God, how should this change the way we live?

13. Being sent into this world in the name of Jesus is the task of a disciple. How often do you feel like Moses when confronted with this task? What can you do to change this?

14. How are we to do life in the name of Jesus? What does this look like in practice?
