

Study 8—Imperfect Worship—Exodus 25-40



1. Draw a picture depicting the glory of God.



2. Skim Read Exodus 25-30. Closely, read 25:1-9. Why is so much of this book taken up with the detail of the tabernacle?

3. Why does the pattern have to be followed exactly?

4. Read Exodus 32. After all that the Israelites had been through and seen, within 40 days, they had turned from their promise in Ex. 24. What was the promise, and how did they break it?

5. What does God mean by stiff necked people?

6. Is God's anger sinful? How is God's anger different to our own?

7. What is the problem with Aaron's self defence? (v24) What does this tell us about human excuses in the face of the divine God?

8. Read Exodus 40:17-38. What is the significance of Moses' obedience? Where does God now dwell?



10. Read John 1:1-14. Where does God dwell now?

11. Read Hebrews 8. How do worshippers worship God today?



12. What would you say to someone who said that there was a particular human activity which MUST be done in order to worship God?

13. How is your worship of God imperfect? What should our response to that imperfection be? (See Hebrews 8:10-12)

14. Share your most significant point from the book of Exodus

Pray, thanking God for his word, and the fact that we have the one true worshipper, Jesus, worshipping God perfectly in our place.
